APPLICANT POLICY

CRITERIA FOR TRAINEESHIP

1. The applicant must have a disability, which has a moderate influence on their ability to work.
2. The applicant must qualify for a permanent grant from the dept. of Social Services (SASSA) or a similar institution.
3. The applicant must commit to, be self-motivated for and have the endurance to attend to a work activity for a (8 hour) day.
4. The applicant must be able to follow verbal instructions to complete a task as well as be able to identify differences between items etc.
5. The applicant and their care givers must be able to accept the policy and procedures that govern Chris Steytler industries.
6. The applicant must be mobile with or without an assistive device or wheelchair.
7. The applicant must be appropriate and independent when taking care of toileting, eating, self-care etc.
8. The applicant must be able to get themselves to work on time- either with public transport or to arrange own private transport (Dial-a-Ride is familiar with Chris Steytler Industries as a 'Drop - off' point).
9. No active addiction (e.g., dagga, alcohol, prescription medication) will be tolerated. Previous admissions or prolonged using is to be disclosed at application level.

Please note:

- Persons with severe antisocial behaviour, severe intellectual fall out or extreme behavioral problems will not be considered for traineeship.
- All active rehabilitation (e.g., physiotherapy) must be completed by the time of application and condition be stable.
- The minimum age of admission is 18 years old, maximum age of admission is 60 years old.
- Transport to and from Chris Steytler is to be arranged and paid for by the applicant.
- There is no fee required to train at Chris Steytler Industries.

DOCUMENTS NEEDED FOR APPLICATION

1. Completed application form.
2. Current reports from health professionals e.g., Doctor, OT, psychologist, social worker, discharge reports, final year functional performance (school) reports from OT etc.
3. Doctor completed proof of diagnosis / proof of receiving a SASSA grant.
